Read: John 15:16

16 “You didn’t choose Me. I chose you. I appointed you to go and produce lasting fruit, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for, using My name.”

Welcome: (This is a time for us to focus inward on our relationships with one another.)

Briefly share the goals and one guideline of Life Group (Found at the back of the book)

Ice breaker Question: If you happened to find a magic lamp with a genie inside who offered to give you ONE thing, what would you ask for?

Question: Last week we talked about developing a strong friendship with Jesus. Which “call to action” did you accomplish?

Memorize: Spend time this week memorizing John 15: 16.

Try different methods to help you memorize this Scripture such as writing it on a notecard, making a note on your phone, sharing it with someone or using the Verses app (Available on the App store).

Word: Discuss the following questions.

- What are one or two things that stood out to you from the video or the Scripture?
- According to John 15:16, who chose us and why were we chosen?
- Pastor Dennis said “*An apple tree produces apples and an orange tree produces oranges and a banana tree produces bananas, a real Christian will produce other Christians.*” Who have you produced since coming to know the Lord?
- Pastor Dennis said “*It’s not just enough to share our faith with someone one time... We must continue to nurture the new follower of Jesus until they become strong and lasting followers of Jesus.*” Who can you identify in your life that you are currently “nurturing” in the faith?
- Who (if anyone) would you consider has played a major role in “nurturing” you on your journey to follow Jesus?
- What are some challenges that someone may encounter (or you have personally encountered) when ‘nurturing’ someone into becoming a strong and lasting follower of Jesus?

Breakouts: Break into smaller, gender-specific groups of 3-4 for discussion

- What is a significant truth you have learned or been reminded of through the discussion or video?
- Who have you been reaching out to lately in order to help him/her become a lasting follower of Jesus Christ?
- How do you plan to grow this coming week? Which “call to action” will you put into practice?

Ready, Set, Grow. (Call to Action)

Encouragement: Compile a list of people you know who either need to come to faith in Jesus or who need to grow in their relationship with Jesus. Commit to praying for and reaching out to them.

Confession: If you are currently not sharing your faith or committed to helping others grow into lasting followers of Jesus, take time to pray for them today. As you pray, ask for forgiveness from the Lord for not sharing with them. Then, ask for the boldness to share your faith.

Worship: Spend time journaling this week. Write out your prayer to the Lord asking Him to transform three specific areas in your life. These could be spiritual, relational, financial, or emotional.
