WELCOME (5-10 minutes) - Welcome everyone. This is a time for us to focus inward on our relationships with one another. [Share the Goals and ONE Guideline at this time.](#) Here is one goal and one guideline for you, in case you don't have time to pull it up:

Goal of the week: *To grow members of the group to leadership readiness and multiply new groups – Discipleship*

Guideline of the week: *When speaking, we will address the group and not just the leader*

Ice Breaker: Go around the group and let everyone answer the following question:

- If you were going to be in the Summer Olympics, what would your sport be? (Hint: You can make one up.)

WORSHIP (10-15 minutes) - This is a time for us to focus upward on our relationship with the Lord. Prepare a creative worship time that can be enjoyed by children, teens, and adults. You will release the children to Kids' Slot time after the worship.

WORD (15-20 Minutes) - Read Exodus 11:4-8

- What were some of the prior injustices that the Egyptians committed against the Israelites?
- How did God plan to bring about justice?
- Looking at verse 7, how did the Lord distinguish between the Egyptians and the Israelites?
- **Read Exodus 12:12-13.** What did the blood on the houses represent?
- If the blood on the posts were visible indications of the Israelites covenant with God, what are some outward representations of our relationship with Jesus?
- How does the passover story relate to the Gospel?
- Describe a time when you personally experienced injustice. (**LEADERS:** Be prepared to listen and have [empathy](#) with those who have suffered injustice.)
- Why do we sometimes want justice for others and grace for ourselves?
- How can we endure patiently while the Lord brings about justice for our lives?

WITNESS (10-15 minutes)

BREAKOUT LEADERS: The BREAKOUT is intended to cultivate transparency, accountability, and relationships that can later serve as a pathway for ongoing equipping and discipleship. *Identify and recruit prospective leaders in advance.* You should consult the [Goals and Guidelines](#) for Breakout Leaders to help you identify, as well as, prepare future BREAKOUT and multiplication Leaders.

Break into smaller, like-gendered groups of 3-4. Address the following questions:

- What is a significant truth that you have learned or been reminded of today?
- Are there any areas of your life that you would be afraid for God to judge?
- How can we help support you, encourage you, or hold you accountable this week?
- How else can we pray for you this week?
